OUR PLEDGE

To make our school communities as safe as possible we have implemented our WeCare pledge. This set of stringent health and safety guidelines will ensure that our students can fully enjoy their experience with us while being confident that they are in the safest possible environment.

We have put in place a number of practical procedures that will help protect our students from the moment they arrive at their destination of choice.

YOUR ARRIVAL

If requested we will provide students with a safe transfer from the airport. Our drivers have received COVID-19 health and safety training and all vehicles will be fully sanitized prior to pickup to ensure student safety.



We have implemented daily temperature checks using infrared technology at all of our schools for both staff and students and everyone will receive a care kit on arrival which will include facemasks and 70 % + alcohol hand sanitiser gel. Hand sanitiser gel will be freely available throughout our schools and students will be shown where they can find it at induction and encouraged to use it frequently.



STUDENT SERVICES TEAM

Our on-site student services team will monitor the wellbeing of our students. They have longestablished relationships with local doctors and healthcare advisers, which are based at medical practices within a short distance of each school.

Students will receive a health and safety briefing during their first day induction and all our staff are fully trained in relation to COVID-19. Everyone will be required to wear masks.



YOUR SCHOOL

To create a safe and productive school environment class sizes have been reduced, classroom seating has been adjusted, timetables and breaktimes have been staggered and the flow of students through our schools have been managed to maintain safe social distancing.

All schools have implemented an increased cleaning regime, with classrooms and communal areas undergoing cleaning during the course of the school day. We now limit outside visitors to our schools and accommodation and there are special procedures for deliveries.

We know that a rich part of the Stafford House experience is taking part in our extensive activities and excursions programme. To maintain this, each has undergone a thorough risk assessment and where necessary we offer an online alternative.



GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES

We appreciate that government guidance around COVID-19 is constantly changing and evolving and we will adhere closely to the guidelines set out in England and Canada.

QUARANTINE

If quarantine measures are required at any time, we will facilitate students to isolate safely in their accommodation and assist with making them comfortable.

We will provide an online induction before face-toface classes and activities begin, giving students the opportunity to learn more about the school and start making friends.

STUDENT CARE

If students display symptoms of COVID-19, we will isolate them safely in their accommodation, so they can continue their studies online until they are ready to return to class. We will assist with local healthcare appointments.

At Stafford House we have developed a robust online offering allowing us to adapt quickly and efficiently should any circumstances change. This means that our students won't miss a beat in their studies and can be confident in achieving their English goals!
