

SUPPORTING OUR STUDENTS THROUGH COVID-19

Study in Safety at Frances King.

We closely follow UK Government guidelines and have put many safety measures in place to keep you and our staff safe at the school:

- You are required to keep a 1-meter distance from staff and other students at all times; class sizes are smaller than usual and depend on classroom size
- · Face coverings must be worn in common areas and teachers wear plastic visors to minimise risk in classrooms
- · Hand sanitiser is available at key points around the school
- · Classrooms, common areas and toilets are cleaned and sanitised regularly throughout the day
- Class start and finish times, as well as breaks, are staggered to ensure minimum numbers of students are in common areas at the same time
- · Each course group is assigned their own classroom and have only one teacher to reduce any risk of contamination between groups
- · Where it is not against fire safety regulations, doors and windows are left open to ensure ventilation throughout the building
- · You have your own course book and extra materials (where possible) are provided digitally

We will continue to implement measures as recommended by the Government and Industry Associations.






